
New Playground Hamilton Downs

There was a smoking ceremony conducted in Santa Teresa by the community members in conjunction with a blessing by Bishop Charles Gauci to ensure it was cleansed, pure and blessed prior to its use by the students and staff of the Santa Teresa school.

To see this seamless combination of cultural practice between old and new was very engaging and a credit to the community.

The ceremonies were conducted by the principal of the School, Justin Colley, along with Bishop Charles from Darwin, Father Prakash from the Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Parish in Alice Springs and Father Elmer from Santa Teresa.



I was able to visit the community of Orrtipa Thurra, more commonly known as Bonya. I was briefed on the new copper mining operation located at the old Jervois mine about 15 kilometres from the community. The development of the new mine on an old existing mining operation dating back to the early 1900s will be of significant benefit to the Territory economy, but more importantly, a huge benefit to the remote communities in the area. For the mine construction phase there will be employment for up to 300 people and in the production phase and ongoing mining there may be ongoing employment for up to 100 people in various roles.
